Please refrain from contacting us about the vaccine as we are awaiting delivery of the vaccine prior to booking any patients in. Once stock is received Milton Surgery will contact those patients aged 80 years or over directly to arrange your vaccination appointment. Milton Surgery has become aware of text scams that are going around in relation to the COVID-19 vaccine. As such, we will **NOT** be contacting patients via text. For those who are eligible to receive a vaccine at the Practice, we will contact you by telephone. We will identify who we are and why we are telephoning.

Please note that the COVID-19 vaccine is being delivered by the NHS. There is **NO FEE** for this. If you are asked to pay a fee for this or to give your bank details, then the caller is not from the NHS.

As above, please do not phone the surgery regarding queries re the vaccine. Our telephone lines are currently very busy with the usual queries so we need to keep them free to allow us to continue to support our patients. As noted above, please contact NHS Inform with your queries.

As more information is released on the vaccination programme, and the role Milton Surgery will play in it, we will communicate this to patients via this page, our website, and via social media.
